English language proficiency is a basic requirement of GLI Certificate/Non-degree Programs. To help the Admissions Committee evaluate non-native speakers of English, GLI requires applicants submit proof of their level of English language abilities.

A score \geq TOEFL 68 iBT, IELTS band 6.0, or TOEIC 620 (Listening & Reading Test or Speaking & Writing Tests) is necessary for admission to GLI. However, you are exempt from this requirement if you have recently studied full-time for one uninterrupted academic year at a university-level institution in which English is the language of instruction and in a country in which English is a dominant language.

Admitted students with scores \leq TOEFL 80 iBT, IELTS band 6.5, or TOEIC 750 (Listening & Reading Test) and Level 6 (Speaking & Writing Tests) are expected to enroll in supplemental English language courses at GLI.
